SCHOOL UNIFORM & OUTDOOR CLOTHING:

Can everyone please make sure all uniform items are clearly marked with your child's name and class? Please ensure your child brings a coat (with hood or a hat) to school every day. We often walk to Mass or complete lessons outdoors regardless of the weather. Children can wear a fleece during class if they wish.

HEALTH & SAFETY

In the interests of everyone's safety can we please ask all adults and children to:-

- use the small gate when going to and from school and not to use the car park gate at any time;
- use the front door when going to and from school if there is snow or ice and <u>not</u> go across the main playground.

PARKING AT THE SCHOOL GATE

It is very important that everyone remembers not to park on the yellow lines outside the small gate at any time! The markings are there to help keep everyone safe and we really don't want anyone to have an accident.

HEALTHY LUNCH BOXES:

Just a little reminder that 'Healthy Lunch Box Day' is every day. It is great to see many children bringing fruit yoghurts, jelly, custard and fruit instead of chocolate snacks or crisps. Children can bring a small treat in their lunchbox on a Friday.

WATER IN SCHOOL:

All children are encouraged to drink water during the school day and drinking water is available in all classrooms. Some children already bring in their own bottle, please ensure that it is filled with water only, **diluted juice or fizzy drinks are not allowed**. Please encourage your child to bring a water bottle to school every day.


