## SCHOOL CLOSURE

As you are aware, Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup>, Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> & Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March are due to be normal teaching days. However, in-light of ongoing health concerns, we made the decision to change these days to Staff Development & Baker Days.

On these days, children stay at home while our staff will be in school continuing with their preparations for remote learning, in the event of our school closing due to COVID-19/Coronavirus.

While closure of school is imminent, our teachers and classroom assistants have been working diligently to prepare learning materials for our children. We will continue to work on these learning packs, plan for remote teaching and learning strategies over the next few days.

We are conscious this decision has been made at very short notice and we apologise wholeheartedly for this and any inconvenience caused to you. We know you will appreciate that this is an unprecedented and critical situation for us all. It is our aim to keep the health and well-being of our children, staff, families and local community at the forefront of all our decisions and actions as we attempt to navigate these unchartered times. At the moment school will be open as normal on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March and we intend to follow guidance from the Department of Education and Public Health Agency.

We take this opportunity to remind everyone that social distancing is now the most sensible and responsible way to slow the spread of Coronavirus. Even though your child or you may not be showing any signs/symptoms, you may still be carrying the virus and risk infecting others, including those more vulnerable than you.
